Prior Learning

The course builds on prior learning by continuing to develop the four skills of the language as well as vocabulary items and grammatical knowledge seen in French GCSE under the Themes of French Identity and Culture; Local, National, International and Global Areas of Interest; and Current and Future Study and Employment. Students will continue to develop strategies for understand familiar and unfamiliar written and spoken language, gain a much deeper and wider understanding and mastery of grammar and varied tenses for writing, as well as develop their fluency and spontaneity in speaking for a variety of purposes.

Curriculum Intent - What are the curriculum aims?

- To develop deep knowledge including a range of facts and statistics on "Les Aspects de la Société Francophone" and "La Culture Artistique dans les Pays Francophones".
- To develop and enhance vocabulary knowledge on a wide variety of topics linked to the above in order to tackle complex and authentic texts and audio stimuli.
- To reach a level of fluency enabling spontaneous speaking on topics such as Family, Internet, Volunteering, Heritage, Music, and Cinema.
- To build confidence to use French as a natural means of communication in the classroom between teachers and peers.
- To explore French grammar and tenses to achieve an excellent level of accuracy for translation and written essay work on the film studied.
- To watch and study scene by scene the French film Entre les Murs by Laurent Cantet to analyse the plot, characters, themes and aims of the director and to write structured essays on these aspects.

A02 – PAPER 2 - Writing – 1hr 30 minutes

AO3 – PAPER 3 – Speaking – 12–14 minutes (Speaking exam conducted by Teacher-Examiner)

- End of unit sub-topic tests for each of those studied including Listening, Reading and Writing, Speaking Stimulus cards, Writing Essays related to the study of the film.
- Regular vocabulary tests on topics covered.
- Peer/Solo presentations.
