# **The Mitel 5312 Handset**

The Mitel 5312 handset is a full feature dual port telephone that provides communication over an IP network.

The Personal Key on the bottom left is always your Prime Line (your Extn); the remaining keys can be programmed with Features, Speed or Line Appearances.

# Mitel 5312 Menu Options:-



Select options in the screen Use the key pad \*, 0, #


EXAMPLE: \* = Yes, 0 = Default, # = No



# Find your Extension Name & Number:-

- Press the bottom left hand side key which is the Prime line Key the display will show the Extension number.

#### Volume:-



- Ringing Press arrows repeatedly to change the volume whilst ringing
- Handset Receiver Press arrows repeatedly to change the volume whilst on a call
- Hands free Press arrows repeatedly to change the volume whilst on a call

#### **Contrast**



• Contrast - Press arrows repeatedly whilst the phone is in idle state

# Pitch:-



- Press the Super/menu Key
- Press # = No until Ringer Adjust is Displayed
- Press \* = Yes, twice
- Press the arrow up or down until the pitch is correct
- Press the Super/Menu Key or # to Save

# Super / Menu Key




The Menu / Super Key has 6 Options:-

- Phone Book –All Extensions and outside numbers
- Advisory Message (If programmed shows caller why you are unavailable)
- Call Forward Forwarding options to divert your handset
- Personal Keys Program keys
- Ringer Adjust Change the Pitch and Volume.
- Language English, French or Italian.



## **Call Handling:-**

#### To Answer a Call



(Private Call)

• Press the flashing prime line Key (Hands free or Headset)

# To Make a Call

- Lift Handset for a private call or leave the handset down for a hands free call
- Dial the extension number or 9 for an outside line and the number

# **End the Call**

- Hang up the Handset
- Press Cancel
- (Hands free or Headset)
- Press the Speaker Key (Hands free or Headset)

#### To Hold A Call

The caller listens to comfort tones

If you forget about your call on hold it will recall after a set period (30 secs default).

- Press Hold △□□
- You can replace the handset if you wish.

# **Retrieve Held Call**

• To retrieve the call press the key that will be flashing.

#### Mute a Call

The caller will get silence you can hear the caller.

- Press disables the microphone
- Solid orange light caller cannot hear
- Press 🌶 again to go back to the caller

#### To Transfer a Call

- Press Trans/Conf
- Dial the number
- Announce the Call or Not
- Hang up the handset

## To Cancel a Transfer

• Press Cancel



# **Transfer to Voicemail**





- Enter the Voicemail Extension Number 500 & \*#
- Enter the mailbox number (Extension number)
- Hang up

#### Transfer to the Phone book

- Press Transfer
- Press Phonebook (follow the instructions for the phone book)
- To cancel the transfer press the cancel



# Conference Calls (5 to 8 people, internal or external)

- With a caller on one line
- Press Trans/Conf
- Dial the next caller
- Wait to speak to them
- To join the conference press the Trans/Conf button twice
- Repeat to add more to the conference.

# **Pickup**

Ability to pick up a ringing extension within your group (Programmed by Engineer)

- Lift your handset
- Press the Pickup Key

#### Redial

Press Redial 14 to dial the last external number you rang.

#### Phonebook

- Press the MENU).
- Phonebook
- Press \* = Yes
- Enter approx 3 letters of the Name using your keypad
- Lookup →

- \* = Left to Correct.
- 0 = Look up
- # = Spare
- Shows Name in screen
  - \* = Call (Rings)
  - 0 = Next (to see another entry with same/similar name)
  - # = Retry (Start search again)

# **Messaging - Call-back**

• Leave a call-back message when you reach a busy or unanswered extension

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- Press the message Key
- Hang up or Cancel 🕟
- Initiates a flashing message light on their handset.

#### Responding to a Call back Message

- Press the flashing message Key
- Shows Callers ID
- \* =Erase or # =Call



Call Forwarding – (Divert) A manual fwd over-rides a System Forward.

# Forwarding options:-

- $\hfill \square$  Always Immediate without ringing.
- ☐ B-Int Re-directs internal calls if busy.
- ☐ B-Ext- Re-directs external call if busy
- □ NA-Int Re-directs internal call after set amount of rings
- □ NA-Ext Re-directs external call after set amount of rings

#### Set a Forward:

- Press the Menu/Super Key
- Press # until Call Forwarding appears
- Press \* to select the fwd
- Press # until type of call forward that you want to set up appears
- Press \* = Review
- Press \* = Change
- Press \* = Program
- Dial the destination number (don't forget 9 if its an outside number)
- Press The Volume down arrow/Save Soft key (you need to turn it on)
- Press \* = Change
- Press # = turn on.
- Press Cancel twice (to hang up)

# **Disable the Forwarding**

- Press the Menu/Super Key
- Press # = No until call Forwarding appears
- Press \* = Yes
- Press \* = Review keep pressing # to view the fwd you want to change.
- Press \* = Change
- Press # = Turn off.

# To Re-use a Forward:-

- Press the Setting/Super Key
- Press # = No until Call Forwarding appears
- Press \* = Yes to select the fwd
- Press # = Next until type of call forward that you want to set up appears
- Press \* = Review soft key
- Press \* = Change soft key (Shows what's already stored)
- Press # = turn on.
- Press Cancel twice (to hang up)

#### **Forward Feature Key**

• Toggles Forward Always (immediate) on and off (Remembers last number used)



# **Programming a Speed Call**



- Super/Menu Key
- Press # = No until Personal keys? appears
- Press \* = Yes
- Press the key you wish to program on
- Press \* = Change
- Dial the number (don't forget to add a 9 for an outside number)
- Press the key you are programming again
- Press \* = Priv (to make it Private)
- Press # = Save (to Keep the number visible)
- Press Super/Menu Key



#### Voicemail

# **Initiating your mailbox.**

- Dial the access code: 500
- Enter your passcode:- 1111
- A voice guide will prompt you to set up your mailbox with:-
- A new passcode (4 digits)
- Recording your name as you liked to be address
- Recording your greeting
- You will get the opportunity to listen and delete and re-record if necessary.

## Pickup up your Messages

- Press your flashing message key
- Press # = Call
- The voicemail will greet you, you will hear your name, in your voice and be prompted to enter your passcode
- The voicemail will tell you how many messages you have.
- Options 7 to Play, 6 New Msg, 8 User Options, 9 Exit and 0 for the Operator
- Press 7 to play the message (time of receipt)
- 7 to play again
- 2 to Answer (return the call, leaving the message)
- 3 to Discard
- 4 to Give (Forward to another mailbox)
- 5 to Keep
- 6 to Play Envelope (when the message arrived and from whom)
- 8 next Message (skip)

# Pickup a message remotely

- Dial your ddi number or a given ddi number
- Press \* \*
- Enter your mailbox number
- Enter your passcode

# Pickup a message from another handset

- Dial the voicemail number 500
- Press \* \*\*
- Enter your mailbox number
- Enter your passcode

# Changing Your Greeting (Make sure that you exit using 9 to apply the changes)

- Dial the voicemail number 500
- Enter your passcode
- User Option 8
- Option 4 Record the Greeting #
- Option 5 to listen
- Option 9 Changes will now be applied.




# **Changing Your Passcode**

- Periodically change your passcode and using 4 digits for security
- Dial the voicemail number 500
- Enter your passcode
- User Option 8
- Option 7 Enter your new Passcode
- To Confirm Enter the new passcode again

# **Temporary Greeting**

- Set up a greeting with an expiry time to go back to the everyday greeting
- Dial the voicemail number 500
- Enter your passcode
- Press 8 for User Options
- Press 8 for Change temporary Greeting
- Enter the number of days to use the temporary greeting
- If the temporary greeting is for 1 day only press 1
- Option given to record greeting
- If greeting already recorded option to Listen, Re-record or Disable.

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
